Online Fish Entry Instructions

Steps to enter fish online:

Go to www.muskiesinc.org

Click on the Members Only tab

Log in using your 5-digit Muskies Inc. membership number

If you are logging in for the first time, follow the instructions on the MI website to establish a log in and password

Once logged in, click the link to online fish submission

Fill in the online version of the release form with all necessary information. Remember that we only report fish to MI that are 30 inches or more

Once you have all the necessary information entered, click submit fish. Once you submit, it will give you a 6-digit lunge log ID number. Once you get this number, you have entered your fish successfully.

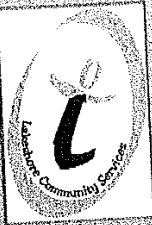
