Presidents Message

The Fall Shoot-out Tournament at Alum turned out very well. 30 fishermen caught 12 legal fish. Fish were caught both casting and trolling. Chuck McKnight was the winner with 2 fish. This was the last event for the Tournament Championship and Mark Steinert held on to win, but only by a few points.

Chuck Wilbert and George Smart stayed with me that week. We ended up with 14 fish, but George had the hot hand, with 5 fish over 40". These included a 51.5" and a 49.5".
